

IE UNIVERSITY MASTER'S SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarship amounts are determined by the IE Scholarship Committee taking into consideration several factors, including (1) an applicant's strength based on the eligibility criteria of each scholarship, (2) demonstrated financial need versus other applicants for the same scholarship(s), and (3) the amount of funds available at the time of application. Please bear in mind that the scholarship awarding process is competitive and funding is limited; note that complying with the minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee a favorable resolution.

With few exceptions, our scholarships are intended to cover only a part of students' tuition fees, meaning that fees will be reduced by the amount specified. They may not be used to pay the place reservation deposits or any other fee. IE Foundation contribution will not be affected, compensated, or replaced by any type of scholarship or award.

The scholarships are awarded for a specified program and intake. Scholarships are not transferrable and will not be retained if you choose to defer your entry to a different intake or if you choose to transfer to a different program at IE.

You can only hold a maximum of one IE scholarship/award towards a program. Should you qualify for more than one scholarship, the IE Scholarship Committee will offer to you the scholarship of greater value. You may, however, combine your scholarship with loans, partial external scholarships, and other tuition benefits such as those offered through certain corporate partners' schemes or through our IE Alumni Tuition Benefit.

Scholarships/awards are accepted when a candidate (1) signs the enrollment contract, in doing so agreeing to the commitments they must adhere to as a scholarship recipient, and (2) formally reserves the place in their program by the deadline indicated, paying the corresponding deposit. These terms and conditions apply to all scholarships, unless otherwise stated.

For a limited number of scholarships (mainly scholarships offered in partnership with other organizations), the outcome may be notified at a later date. Any scholarship or award recipient who later qualifies and is offered a higher scholarship will see their original scholarship/award replaced by the new scholarship, provided they accept it.

Scholarship holders must dedicate themselves to the successful completion of their program of study, maintaining a satisfactory academic performance. Scholarship holders agree to take part in a range of promotional activities.

Scholarship holders are expected to contribute importantly to the future of IE by engaging in promoting and further developing our university and its programs, advocating for future scholarship recipients and being an active and engaged IE alumni.

For certain scholarships or awards, additional terms and conditions may apply for the holders.

Scholarship decisions are final. The IE Scholarship Committee cannot newly revise your application unless you are able to demonstrate significant and unexpected changes to your financial situation that have occurred since the submission of the initial application.

The decision-making processes for individual applications carried out by the IE Scholarship Committee are confidential. Specific information will not be provided regarding the assessment of each application submitted, the motives behind the amount granted, nor for rejected applications.

All the information provided in your application must be true and complete. Providing false or incomplete information may result in an applicant facing penalties or sanctions in function of the severity and intentional nature of the information falsely reported or withheld.
